We would like to welcome you to the team! Whether you are a prayer warrior, missionary care giver or financial supporter, you are playing an essential part of taking the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the world. YOU are partaking in the Great Commission.

For every "goer" there must be six to thirty active senders. In fact, there are *five* critical roles in getting the Good News to the world. We are all called to reach the nations. To which role is God calling you?



Senders - The key ingredients to a sender is generosity and prayer. Although financial support is greatly needed, the sender may perform many tasks. Here are some ideas... Doing research for missionaries on the field where there may not be the resources. Gathering and shipping needed materials to the field. This could include medical, teaching, clothing and food supplies. Use professional expertise to help the missionary or the people to be reached. This may be as simple as supplying dentistry to a missionary who has no insurance or gathering cheap computers for an overseas Bible school.

Mobilizers - These people have a heart to mobilize senders and goers. They desire to see others trained and properly prepared for ministry. They help others find their place of service in reaching the world. They are often networkers and trainers.

Welcomers - Welcomers have a heart for those who are new or passing through the area. They give the missionary a roof over their head while they are in town. They reach out to the international students on the University campus. They welcome the lost into their lives and the new into their church.

Prayer Warriors - We are all called to be in prayer. We are all to be prayerful about the missionaries on the front line. But some are especially called to this ministry. Learn to pray for specifics... specific people groups, specific missionaries and specific circumstances. Do not be surprised if He wakes you in the night to pray for us. God *will* work through your prayers!

Goers - We are currently shifting from the role of sender to the role of goer. Our job is to carry the Word of God to the world. Many have never heard the Good News of Christ. To them we shall go!

You - There are no one-man-bands in the Great Commission. We are a team of senders, mobilizers, welcomers, prayer warriors and goers. In short, we are a team of Christians. The roles are simply definitions of what we should be anyway. We are sojourners on this earth who walk by faith and not by sight!

1 Corinthians 3:5-8 summarizes our job. We are simply to water and plant, then watch God cause the increase. What is your part in the Great Commission?
